Thank you for your interest in the Tohkomeupog Association. We are a non-profit alumni organization - governed by volunteers - and guided by a sincere desire to support the spirit of Tohkomeupog. As part of this effort, we manage the E. Milton Hoyt Scholarship Fund. While we ask for your patience, we will work as quickly as our situation allows.
