Overnight facilities at Family Camp range from rustic, screened-cabins to economy-style lodge rooms. Camp cabins have electricity, cold water sinks and flush toilets (showers in a separate building). Lodge rooms have full private baths. Bed linens are provided. Lodge rooms receive towel and trash service daily.

Hearty Meals:



Family Camp has a private dining room and dedicated cooking staff. We are able to satisfy most dietary needs. Most meals are served buffet style and include several entrées, salads, sides and desserts. We also enjoy a few meals, cooked over open flame, served outside near the shores of Purity Lake.

This is a large property with many options. Box lunches may be provided (with 24-hour notice) for those wishing to spend some time on their own.

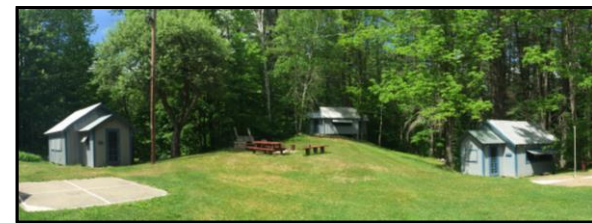
