Packing for Camp

GEAR LIST...

The following list is provided to help you and your child prepare for Ski & Snowboard Camp. Of course you may choose to add other items to this list. There are no laundry facilities available at camp, so it is very important to pack enough clothing to get through the entire week of camp.

Toiletries	Extra Warm Clothes	Ski Pants / Ski Parka / Jacket
Socks	Sweaters / Fleece	Helmet (<i>mandatory; may be rented</i>)
Underwear	Thermal Socks / Underwear	Ski Goggles
Pajamas	Mittens / Gloves / Hat	Ski / Board Equipment (<i>may be rented</i>)
Slacks or jeans	Comfortable Indoor Footwear	Swimsuit (<i>we have an indoor pool</i>)
Shirts	Outdoor Boots / Shoes	Towels (<i>for both bathing & swimming</i>)

Optional Gear...

Flashlight – will be very useful (*recommended*)

Camera – lots of memories to capture

Skates – can be rented if desired (*please do not bring hockey sticks to ski camp*)

ASSORTED GADGETRY...

There are so many little gadgets available these days; I can't even begin to list all the things that could possibly appear with somebody at camp. I have no doubt there are campers out there who own a variety of devices they are thinking of bringing. Here are some general thoughts to help guide you in this process...

- In general, any devices that become a disruption to the camp program... or that are being used in a way seen as detrimental to camp... will be removed from the camper's possession.
- Campers are responsible for their belongings / valuables. As careful as they intend to be, the risk of something getting broken, lost or stolen should be carefully considered before it gets packed for Camp.

Communication Devices...

Having a cell phone close at hand certainly adds a level of comfort and convenience to daily living. At camp, however, the use of cell phones and other communication devices is limited, both by nature of our location, as well as by camp policy. Such devices are not permitted at tables during meals, during lessons, and during camp program. In terms of communication, please see the document titled, '*Being in Touch with Your Child*'.

Video Players...

Video players and gaming devices will not be needed at Ski & Snowboard Camp and should be left at home. We will provide / create other types of entertainment as a core part of our program.

Music Players...

iPods, MP3 Players and other types of audio entertainment are acceptable, preferably ones that do not have a video component. Music players must include headphones. We will tap into the available music selection for dances and other events. There will be times, however, when their use will not be allowed.

Cameras...

Cameras are a wonderful way to capture special camp memories. With that, we expect good judgment to be exercised before posting photos / images representing Ski & Snowboard Camp at online social media sites. Camp will respond if we discover any posted photos / images which we find offensive, or which may be interpreted by non-camp, public viewers as inappropriate and /or negative representations of camp.

HOW TO PACK IT ALL...

Campers will essentially live out of whatever they pack their gear in. Unfortunately, our bunks are not high enough for standard trunks to squeeze under. Some campers have chosen to use those plastic pull-out units that stand maybe 2 or 3 drawers high. Most often campers use some sort of duffle bag or suitcase to hold clothing. These are nice as they are often able to be stashed under beds and out of the way.
