CHARTER BUS...

ARRIVING BY CAR...

If you are driving your child to Ski & Snowboard Camp by car, please plan to arrive **AFTER 3:00PM**. Before that time, we will be setting up for camp and dormitory rooms may not yet be ready. We also may not have staff available for camper supervision. If you would like to enjoy King Pine Ski Area with your child earlier in the day, tickets may be purchased in the base lodge at the guest services desk. Camp staff will be on duty at camp at 3:00PM to begin greeting arrivals and assist campers with getting settled into their rooms.

On the first day of camp:

When you arrive at camp, please come inside the main lodge (Tecumseh) and check in at the camp office. At this time, any outstanding paperwork or payment shall be completed. You will also have an opportunity to visit with a staff member to go over any health concerns... and to drop off all medications being brought into camp.

On the last day of camp:

Sadly, camp will inevitably come to an end, although we don't like to think about it until we have to. For those of you transporting by car, please collect your children sometime between breakfast and 11:00AM. Believe it or not, we have a second week of camp to get ready for.

DRIVING DIRECTIONS...

From points south: Take I-95 North into New Hampshire. After the Portsmouth Toll, take the Spaulding Turnpike towards NH White Mountains / Lakes Region (eventually becomes Rte 16 North). Follow to Ossipee, NH. Take Rte 25 East (exit on right). Turn right off exit; follow 5 miles to Rte. 153 North (left turn at blinking light). Follow about 6 miles to Purity Spring Resort / King Pine Ski Area. Pass through main resort (white buildings on left; indoor pool facility on right). Take first left turn onto East Madison Road and proceed up short hill (you will see our tubing park on your right). Camp sits on top of the hill – the main lodge will be the first large building on your right. Come inside – camp staff will be there to greet you.

From Western Massachusetts: Take I-90 (Mass Pike) to I-290 North through Worcester, MA. Continue to Rte 495 North / East; follow to I-95 North (follow I-95 as above).
